Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM at Broxton Park School		
1) Kelley Hessling made a motion to adopt minutes with changes Sandy seconded. All in favour.		
2) Equipment Cleaning - Chantal mentioned that Ozone Shop would like to come in and do an equipment cleaning demonstration.		
3) Publicity update - Coralee mentioned that the float turned out well. Good girl turnout, 300 pamphlets handed out. Millgrove and John Paul schools had the U of A in to talk about ringette, the response was positive. Trileisure Information Sharing Night, try to get ice for the South arena from 6 to 7:45 to run a showcase, otherwise, cancel ice. If south ice is obtained, Sandy and Kelly Ible will go on the ice, and Chantal, and Cora will run the registration desk for that time. Cora will have an equipment swap at that time as well. Linda and Kelley have offered to help. Equipment should be dropped off at 5:30 at Tri, or at Coralee's house prior. Equipment should be picked up at 9, and if it is still around after 9, the left over equipment will be considered donated. Coralee will run a come and try ringette if the south ice is obtained. Coralee also mentioned that she will resend the survey, and asked if the directors would send it out to the players. Coralee also indicated that she will require 4 sheets of ice for Lorie Horne and Goalie clinics in November.		
4) AA requests - AA have indicated that they are attempting to rebuild a connection with the association, and have asked for volunteers from the association to help them with the AA tryouts, as well as buying ice. They asked for input from the associations as far as ideas about improving tryouts in the club. AA has asked if we would sell them some ice slots in September, it was indicated that there would likely be slots available to sell them.
