Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM at Broxton Park School		
1) Linda made a motion to adopt minutes Kelley Hessling seconded. All in favour.		
2) AA updates - Cheryl stated that she read a response on SGRA concerning the zone 5 AA. She stated there will be 3 petite, 3 tween, 2 junior teams and 1 belle team, providing there is the talent available. Cheryl indicated that the vote went through with only 2 opposed. Marilyn pointed out that the associations have only 5 votes out of 18, therefore, it doesn't really matter what the associations says about the decisions made. Cheryl asked for shared ice practice, and tri-outs ice last week of August. The idea is to bring the try-outs back in the community. She also asked if the association can black out Wednesday's from Petite practices, as this is the day Petite AA practice.		
3) Lorie Horne Coaching Clinic - Lorie Horne coaching clinics/Future Champions. 2002 World champ coach. 2008 Hall of Fame. Justinda and Lorie will both be ½ time, there is a 6 week course and an 8 week course. 1 on ice session with Bunnies 2 coaches, 2 teams. Novice to Junior 2 on ice sessions. Introduce skill development, tailor training to age specific and coaches requirements. Basic fundamental skills used to analyze skills of the players. Typically asks 3 top things that coaches want to know, and trains them on those 3 items. Monday and Tuesday would cover all the teams. Cost \$205 plus gas money. Off ice \$150/hour. 1 off ice intro session - coaches only at beginning of season, then book after thanksgiving giving the coaches time to get to know the kids and the skills that are needed. Athletic development - off ice sessions are cheaper than on ice sessions. Could potentially attach it to the coaches/managers meeting, as only 1 hour is required. Power skating is available as well, and the coaches are required on the ice.		

4) Publicity – Coralee will resend survey. She also decided a pamphlet, She also designed a pamphlet to hand out at the farmers day parade, schools etc. Coralee talked about the Tri Leisure in August and for the wondered if she had to book a table. She also talked about bring a friend and equipment swap. She will check if she can get ice.		
5) Parade – locker room idea. Linda will check for benches.		
6) Registration – need an ad in paper for registration.		
7) Open Registration – Kelly asked if it would be appropriate for her to attend registration, and inform any new players, that the Open team is a competitive team, and therefore, require certain expectations. She requested 15 skaters 2 goalies. It was felt that this was a capping issue, and based on the current fees, was not feasible.		
8) Round Table – discussion ensued around the new age group names. Discussion was tabled until more information was learned. Should not affect registration.		
9) Upcoming Ice scheduling Meeting – Lynda may need some extra help at the ice scheduling meeting coming up at the Tri. It was felt that the more SGRA members there the stronger the voice.		
10) Tryouts – consist of 2 conditioning and 3 tryout times.
