

**Spruce Grove Ringette Association (SGRA) Executive Motions Made and Carried  
in the 2005 - 2006 Season  
(May 29, 2005 to March 9, 2006)**

**1. 2005/2006 Registration Fees - May 29, 2005**

Donna Smith motioned to accept the following as registration fees for the 2005-2006 SGRA season:

Bunnies	\$275.00
Novice	\$375.00
Petite	\$425.00
Tween	\$425.00
Junior	\$475.00
Open	\$525.00
Master	\$525.00

With a reduction of \$100.00 to first time Bunny and Novice players.

Motion seconded by Brad Sonnenberg. Motion carried.

**2. 2006/2007 SGRA Registration Fees - March 9, 2006**

Donna made a motion that 2006/07 registration fees remain as 2005/2006:

Bunny \$275.

Novice \$375.

Petite to Tween \$425.

Junior & Belle \$475.

Open & Masters \$525.

1<sup>st</sup> time players in the Bunny & Novice levels will receive a discount of \$100.

Lindsay seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**3. Late Registration Discount for Transferring Players - January 12, 2006**

Tammy motioned "If a player requests to transfer from a different ringette association to SGRA after December 31, they will be given a \$100. discount plus a discount of the Ringette Alberta fees, if there is space on the applicable team. If a player requests to register with SGRA prior to December 31, full fees are required." Sandy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**4. Bunny Division, Age of Players - February 9, 2006**

Patti Malmas motioned that SGRA Bunny age division be open to players ages 5 to 7 as of December 31 of that registration year. Sandy seconded. Motion carried

**5. Returned Cheque Policy - October 27, 2005**

Donna Smith made a motion for SGRA to have a standard \$25. fee for cheques returned for insufficient funds. Kelley Hessling seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**6. Travel Reimbursement** – January 12, 2006

Linda made a motion to replace a previous motion “SGRA will reimburse travel costs at the same rate as Ringette Alberta for members representing SGRA to attend zone & provincial meetings beyond the greater Edmonton area.” Donna Smith seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**7. Tim Horton’s Sponsorship** – February 9, 2006

Trish Haryett motioned to set up a sponsorship partnership with Tim Hortons. Tim Hortons will:

- i. purchase home and away jerseys for the Bunny and Novice divisions. Each jersey will have the SGRA crest in the front and a small Tim Horton crest in either the left or right front shoulder area.
- ii. The jerseys will be replaced every 3 years. As we need, they will add or replace each year to meet our needs.
- iii. Tim Hortons will purchase medals for these divisions for our Sweetheart Tournament.
- iv. Tim Hortons will provide a water bottle for all participants in this division for the Sweetheart Tournament as well as timbits for each team.
- v. There are no monetary donations from Tim Hortons.
- vi. The Bunny and Novice divisions within SGRA would be named “timbit division”.

Motion seconded by Sandy Flaming. Motion carried

**Acknowledgement of Current Sponsors.**

As a part of the acceptance of the Tim Horton proposal, the executive agreed that the current sponsors need better recognition. Trish will have a nice sponsorship board made to post on the bulletin board outside the concession acknowledging our sponsors. This will be hung up before the Sweetheart Tournament.

**8. Ringette Scores Against Breast Cancer** – October 27, 2005

Sandy motioned that SGRA donate \$100.00 to the 24 hour Ringette Scores Against Breast Cancer game. Tammy seconded. Motion carried.

**9. University of Alberta Ringette Camp** – October 27, 2005

Donna Smith motioned that SGRA host a U of A Ringette Club summer camp from Aug 21 to 26, 2006. Kelley Hessling seconded. Motion carried.

**10. Power Skating** for SGRA Teams – January 12, 2006

Sandy made a motion to approve Mr. Brian to come for four weeks to offer power skating to a maximum of \$1,000. Patti seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**11. 2007 Provincials** – February 9, 2006

Donna Smith made a motion that SGRA host Provincials March 16–18, 2007, the level to be determined at a later date, after Ringette Alberta announces 2007 Provincial dates and levels. Kelley Hessling seconded the motion. Motion carried with 1 opposed.

**12. Ice Required After Close of SGRA Base Week For Teams Attending Provincials** – February 9, 2006

Donna Smith motioned that SGRA pay for practice ice costs incurred outside of the Base Week in March by teams hosting or participating in provincials. Glenna Hayes seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**13. Bingo License Renewal** – March 9, 2006

Cora motioned that Spruce Grove Ringette Association re-apply for their bingo licenses for a two-year period from June 1, 2006 to May 31, 2008. Linda seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**14. SGRA Annual Spring General Meeting** – March 9, 2006

Sandy made a motion for SGRA to offer a \$50. discount to members that attend the AGM April 27<sup>th</sup> with an additional \$50. to be added to the registration fees of returning players who have not completed their registration by June 30, 2006. Linda seconded. Motion carried.
